STOCKPILING PASTURE PROGRAM



Reduce feed and feed costs! The Sauk Soil & Water Improvement Group (SSWIG) Batch & Grow Program pays farms for setting aside pasture for a number of days. Stockpiling forage is an excellent method of saving forage for overwinter use without harvesting.

Stockpiling Pasture

- NRCS-approved grazing plan required to receive stockpile payment
- Set aside pasture for 60-80 days
- \$35.50/ acre payment
